

Roach Treatment Preparation Instructions from Slug-A-Bug

Roaches can be difficult to control, but proper preparation can help. The following are some suggestions for best results.

- 1) Empty all kitchen cabinets, pantry cabinets, and remove all items from counter tops.
- 2) Empty under bathroom sinks.
- 3) Any cleaning to cabinets should be done prior to spraying NOT after.
- 4) Place kitchen cabinet and bathroom vanity storage on tables and cover with a sheet of plastic.
- 5) Remove dresser drawers and stack away from baseboards.
- 6) Move all items away from baseboards ex: shoes, clothes, toys, books and small storage.
- 7) Open bathtub pipe trap doors, usually located on back side of the faucets.
- 8) No food should be exposed or in preparation during treatment. Wash all food preparation surfaces after treatment. Ventilate home prior to re-entry.
- 9) Children under the age of 12 months should be out of the home during treatment and remain out for a period of 3 hours. If in doubt consult your doctor.
- 10) All pets should be removed from treated areas. If this is not possible, pets can be placed in a bedroom furthest from the bathroom. Please leave a note, placed on the bedroom door indicating that your pet is inside.

It is not unusual to see more roaches after the treatment than prior. If you still see roaches after 28 days you should have another service.
